SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT and FINAL ORDER

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medical Examiners (the Board), and Cassim Igram, D.O., (Respondent), on Feb 07, 2003, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4), and enter into this Settlement Agreement and Final Order to resolve the contested case currently on file.

1. Respondent was issued license number 02144 to practice medicine and surgery in Iowa on January 28, 1986.
2. Respondent's Iowa medical license is currently active and will next expire on March 1, 2004.
3. A Statement of Charges was filed against Respondent on December 12, 2001, and is awaiting hearing.
4. The Board has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter.

5. Respondent is hereby **CITED** for being disciplined by the Illinois Medical Board. Respondent is hereby **WARNED** that being disciplined by the licensing authority of another state in the future may result in further disciplinary action including, suspension or revocation of your Iowa medical license.

6. Respondent shall provide the Iowa Board of Medical Examiners at least 90 days written notice prior to beginning the practice of medicine under his Iowa medical license.

7. Respondent agrees to fully comply with any and all requirements established by the Iowa Board prior to beginning the practice of medicine under his Iowa medical license.

8. This Settlement Agreement and Final Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case proceeding.

9. By entering into this Settlement Agreement and Final Order, Respondent voluntarily waives any rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations contained in the Statement of Charges, and waives any objections to the terms of this Settlement Agreement.

10. This Settlement Agreement and Final Order is voluntarily submitted by Respondent to the Board for consideration.

11. This Settlement Agreement and Final Order is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Settlement Agreement and Final Order it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

12. The Board's approval of this Settlement Agreement shall constitute a **FINAL ORDER** of the Board.

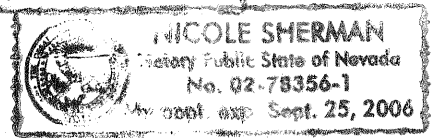
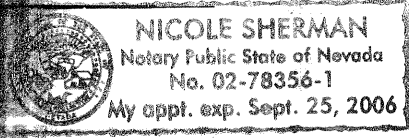
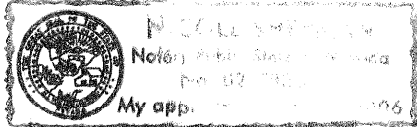

3. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 147, 148 and 272C.


COUNT I


